



Creswell Library Rules of Conduct

To maintain an environment that promotes enjoyment of the Library's resources and services, as well as to protect the safety of all patrons, staff, and materials, please observe the following rules:

1. Any activity in violation of federal, state, or local law is prohibited.
2. Engaging in any sexual conduct will not be tolerated (as defined under ORS 167.060).
3. Footwear and shirts must be worn.
4. Food and drink are not permitted near computers.
5. Children under nine years old must be accompanied at all times by an adult.
6. No animals, except ADA-defined service animals are permitted, except with advance permission of the Library Director.
7. Personal items should not be left unattended nor take up more space than one person would normally use. Staff will not be responsible for personal belongings left unattended.
8. Solicitation, petitioning and distributing written materials is not permitted on Library premises.
9. Cell phone calls must be made/taken in the vestibule or outside.
10. Bikes, skateboards, scooters, hover boards, and roller blades are not to be used inside the library.
11. Anyone who vandalizes library property will be prosecuted.
12. The Library staff may ask patrons to leave if they are disruptive, are disturbing others because of offensive body odor, or are unwilling to follow the Library's Rules of Conduct or reasonable direction from the Library staff.
13. Smoking, vaping, or other use of tobacco is prohibited on Library property.
14. Neither sleeping nor camping is permitted on Library property.
15. Patrons must comply with the Library's Internet Use Policy, including when using the wireless connection.
